## Excavations at Lubenham Hill, Market Harborough



Allen Archaeology Ltd is undertaking an archaeological excavation at the present site as part of the site's development for housing. So far the excavation has revealed mainly Late Iron Age and Roman remains.

The site is probably on the edge of a Roman settlement. The outline of roads/tracks, fields, paddocks, the position of building uprights and drainage gullies survive mainly as filled in ditches and pits. The soil that fills these features contains many finds, the majority of which are pottery to bone.
